



VISA INFORMATION

Entry into Kenya is subject to a visa, except for countries that have signed special agreements with Kenya (listed below). Furthermore, a passport valid for at least six months from the date of entry into Kenya is required.

Participants are requested to make their own arrangements for a single-entry visa to Kenya. If you require a letter of invitation to obtain a visa, please indicate this when registering online and you will hear from our team within 24 hours.



You can apply for a single entry eVisa online [here](#). The Kenyan government recommends that you apply online at least *seven days in advance* of your departure.

Countries exempt from visa requirements in Kenya: Bahamas, Barbados, Belize, Botswana, Brunei, Burundi, Cyprus, Dominica, Ethiopia, Fiji, Gambia, Ghana, Grenada, Jamaica, Kiribati, Lesotho Malawi, Malaysia, Maldives, Mauritius, Namibia, Nauru, Papua New Guinea, Rwanda, St Kitts & Nevis, St. Lucia, Saint Vincent & Grenadines, Samoa, San Marino, Seychelles, Sierra Leone, Singapore, Solomon Islands, South Africa, Swaziland, Tanzania, Tonga, Trinidad & Tobago, Tuvalu, Uganda, Vanuatu, Zambia and Zimbabwe.

Countries exempt from eVisa (must apply in person and referred to the Director of Immigration Services): Afghanistan, Armenia, Azerbaijan, Cameroon, Democratic People’s Republic of Korea (Formerly North Korea), Eritrea, Iraq, Kosovo, Lebanon, Libya, Mali, Palestine, Senegal, Somalia, Syria, Tajikistan

Vaccinations

Kenya requires proof of yellow fever vaccination if you are traveling from a country with a risk of yellow fever.

Countries requiring yellow fever vaccination: Angola, Benin, Burkina Faso, Burundi, Cameroon, Central African Republic, Chad, Congo, Côte d’Ivoire, Democratic Republic of the Congo, Equatorial Guinea, Ethiopia, Gabon, Gambia, Ghana, Guinea, Guinea-Bissau, Liberia, Mauritania, Niger, Mali, Nigeria, Senegal, Sierra Leone, South Sudan, Sudan, Togo, Uganda, Argentina, Bolivia, Brazil, Colombia, Ecuador, French Guiana, Guyana, Panama, Paraguay, Peru, Suriname, Trinidad and Tobago, Venezuela
